Minutes:

Gloria Cowder, Director of Program Development and Extended Learning, welcomed members of the committee. She introduced Kathy Allavie, RUSD Board Member, Lynn Carmen Day, Chief Academic Officer and Dr. Hansen, Superintendent. Gloria opened the meeting by asking committee members to introduce themselves and state one thing for which they are thankful.

Student Feedback from Focus Groups:

Gloria briefly reviewed the process for the student focus groups. Students gave their shared their input at each high school. The committee members were asked to review the information. Suggestions were made by committee members.

LCAP Themes and Priorities:

- a. **Community Forums** – One at each comprehensive high school and the FRC (6 total)
- b. **Stakeholder Groups** – Nine stakeholder groups were held (DELAC, CEDAC, CSEA, RCTA, PTA, LCAP Advisory Committee, Superintendent's LCAP Team, Teacher Advisory Committee and RUSD Principals)
- c. **Student Focus Groups** – Held at each high school and EOC (7 total)
- d. **Comment/Online Input** – Online survey was available from January 15 through March 21, 2016.

We had approximately 500 participants.

LCAP Update and Revision Process:

Gloria explained the guidelines and timelines for updating and making the necessary revisions to the 2015-16 LCAP. The committee reviewed the themes that were suggested and were given a brief description and/or example of the themes. Members were give five colored dots numbered 1 – 5, with five being the most important. The committee members were given time to prioritize and place their dots under their chosen themes. Members were also given the opportunity to place suggestions under each theme. Results will be emailed to members next week.

Governor's Budget:

Sandie Meekins, Director of Business Services, gave a presentation on the RUSD budget. The presentation was made via PowerPoint and handouts.
