Re: Legislation Requirements / Yearly Fiscal Status Report

Dear Mays:

Pursuant to Assembly Bill No. 1666, the Riverside Unified School District must, within seven months after the last day of each fiscal year (starting January 31, 2017), prominently display on its website the following for each CFD:

- 1) Copy of the annual report for that fiscal year pursuant to Section 53343.1
 - Section 53343.1 requires CFDs formed after January 1, 1992 to prepare an annual report including specific information, but only if requested by an interested party
 - To the best of our knowledge, such report has never been requested for any School District CFD
- 2) Copy of the enclosed Mello-Roos and Marks-Roos Yearly Fiscal Status Reports

For your use, enclosed please find the Yearly Fiscal Status Reports for the School District's CFDs and Authority Bonds, which were submitted electronically to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission on October 21 and October 22, 2020.

As mentioned previously, the enclosed Yearly Fiscal Status Reports must be prominently displayed on the School District's website pursuant to Assembly Bill No. 1666 by January 31, 2021.
