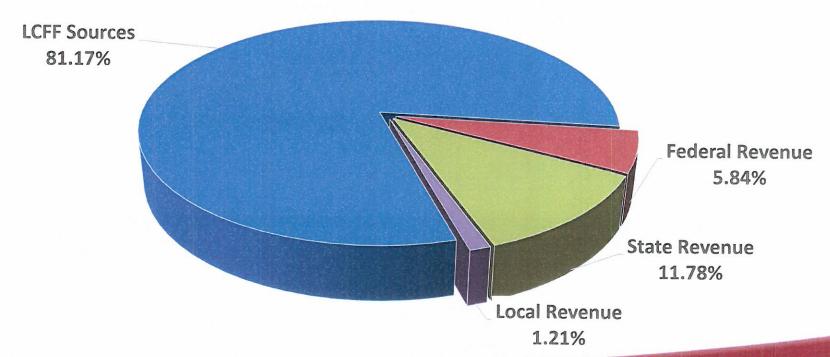

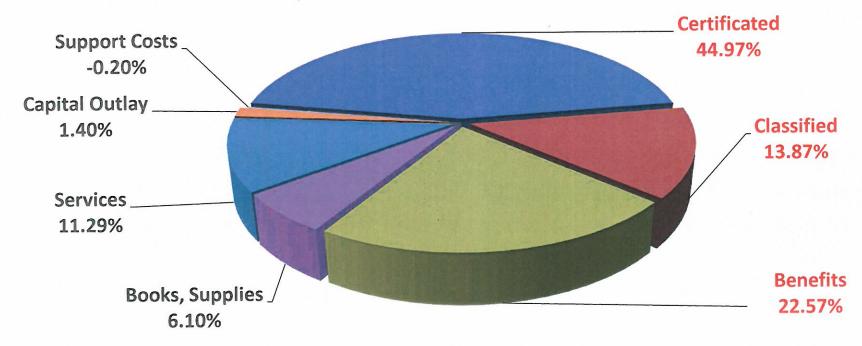
- \$3.7m Unbudgeted Carryover
